

GCI 103 - Coaching Untapped Potential



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Accreditation

Completion of the first two modules within our Coaching Foundation program (GCI 101 and GCI 102) comprises 60 hours of coach specific training. 60 hours is the minimum training requirement required to apply for your International Coach Federation (ICF) Associate Certified Coach credential under the ACSTH pathway.

If you wish to join the ICF, In addition to attending our Coach Training Intensive you will need to complete 10 hours of mentor coaching over a minimum period of three months, gain 100 hours of coaching experience, submit a recording of a coaching session and complete an on line Coach Knowledge Assessment (CKA).
